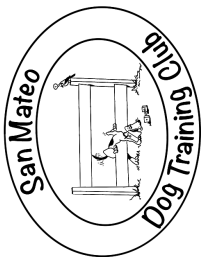
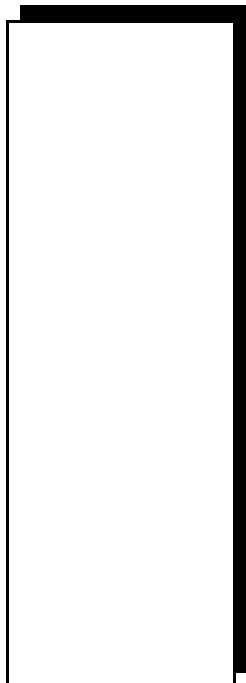

- Dogs without jump heights on entry form will be judged at the end of the class.
- Obedience entries are limited to 7 hours per judge.
- UDX and Preferred UDX classes offered.

- The Rally Trials are limited to 90 entries each trial.
- RAE and RACH classes are offered.
- Rally ring size to be 40' x 50'.

Wait List

These trials have limited entry. The Club will establish a wait list to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to close of entries. All entries must have been received prior to the closing date and time. A Rally wait list will be held after closing to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to Monday November 2, 2026 at 12:00 Noon. The full entry fee shall be refunded to an entrant whose entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry.

Class Transfers Are Allowed

Transfers may be approved provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer requests will be accepted in writing (or email) to the Trial Secretary until the day prior to the trial. Please confirm receipt of request. Transfers on the day of the trial must be presented at the Trial Secretary desk at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Emailed Entries Are Allowed

EMAILED ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE THE AGREEMENT printed alongside the Official AKC Entry Form. Print out the form (both parts together as it is shown), fill it out and sign it. Entries are not valid without your signature. Then either scan the entry to a PDF file, or take a picture with your smart phone. There is also a "fillable" PDF form online at www.going-2-dogs.com. Email your entry form/agreement to DLBest7@earthlink.net.

PAY ENTRY FEES WITH PAYPAL: To make your payment for emailed entries, go to www.Going-2-Dogs.com, then to Upcoming Events. Click on "PayPal Fee Payment" and follow instructions. You do not need to be a PayPal member. Please add **additional \$5.00 PER DOG PER TRIAL** to cover PayPal service charges. (Note, do not put "\$" in the amount field, or you will get an error message.) Entry forms will not be processed until payment has been received, which must be on or before the closing date/time. Electronic payments prior to opening date are not acceptable.

Notice To Exhibitors

- **CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or telephoned entries will not be accepted.** Entries without fees cannot be accepted. See Page 4 for information on emailed entries.
- **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS** or photocopies of entry forms without the **Agreement** and Instructions on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- **PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY** using black or blue ink.
- **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS** on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors.
- **CHANGES**, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Email and faxed changes are acceptable. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- Each entry of a dog in Obedience includes \$4.50 AKC Recording / Event Service Fee. Each Rally entry includes \$4.50 AKC Recording Fee. These fees are included in the prices listed on Page 2.
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** There will be a \$25.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- **THE WELL-BEING OF DOGS** and participants is of paramount importance. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refunds of entry fee(s) will be made. **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS IN A HOT VEHICLE.**
- **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
- **ELECTRONIC CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the email address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If the exhibitor wishes to have a **printed** schedule mailed, please request on the entry form. The Trial Secretary should be contacted if the exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the trial.
- **DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE TRIAL** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.
- **CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM** for time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside when it is their turn to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged.
- **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH** except when being judged in the ring.
- **THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING** nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
- Unentered dogs are not allowed in the trial building.
- In the case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its rights to the prize.
- **ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED THE DAY OF THE TRIAL. NONE WILL BE MAILED** or delivered. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for an award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award
- **THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY**, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.
- **SPECIAL ATTENTION:** No owner or agent shall allow his/her animals to be put in jeopardy of the elements. To do so may result in damaged vehicles during rescue attempts by the event committee.
- **THE AKC IS COMMITTED** to creating a safe and respectful sport environment for all. If you need to talk to someone or *need help*, please call 800.656.HOPE (National Sexual Assault Hotline) or text HOME to 741-741 for free, 24/7, confidential services from trained crisis counselors.
- Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

From Stockton Area – From Hwy 99 take Hwy 88 (2 exits north of Hwy 4). Continue on Hwy 88 to Brandt Road. Turn right onto Brandt Road going east towards the mountains. Cross Clements, take first driveway on the left.

From Sacramento Area – Take Hwy 99 south to Acampo. Exit on W. Peltier (exit 270) and head east for 8 miles. Turn right onto Elliott Road for 3.5 miles. Elliot will become N. Tully Road as it passes through the town of Lockeford. Turn left onto Brandt Road. Cross Clements, take first driveway on left.

Parking and Grounds Information

- **NO OVERNIGHT & NO RV PARKING** is allowed either during the day or overnight. RV's are not allowed on the grounds.
- **NO SMOKING** is allowed on the grounds.
- **VEHICLES MAY NOT BE LEFT IDLING** in the parking area.
- **PARKING IS LIMITED.** Please do not arrive more than one hour before your class. If your class is completed and the parking area is near capacity, please leave to give space to another entrant.
- **CLEAN-UP.** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Potty your dog in dog run or on gravel driveway. Do NOT potty dogs on grass, plants, barn, equipment, side of building, or back of building. Do not allow your dog to potty within 20' of the building.
- **PLEASE KEEP DOGS QUIET.** If barking cannot be controlled, you will be asked to leave. Dogs must be kept **ON LEASH** at all times while on show grounds and parking areas except when being judged in the ring. Note: Farm animals and cats are present on property.
- **RETRACTABLE** leashes (flexi-leads) are permitted, but not to be extended beyond 6 feet in length in the building.
- Please stay away from the house area and respect owners' privacy.
- **NO FOOD VENDORS** will be available at this event. Exhibitors should plan to bring their own snacks and beverages. Fast food is available approximately 15 minutes away.
- **WATER:** Well water is available and safe to drink.

Crating Rules and Trial Procedures

- **RALLY** – Crating will be allowed in the building on Friday/Saturday only. Space is limited and you must crate between the red cones. A **CLEAN TOWEL** and/or **CLEAN MAT** must be placed under your chair and crate to protect the flooring and keep it clean. Please bring your own towel/mat. Spectators are allowed. No dogs on the couch!
- NO X-pens in the building. NO crate aggressive dogs in the building. A dog not entered in the trial is not allowed in the building. There is room to warm up outside on the patio.
- Rally exhibitors may leave their crates overnight in the building on Friday night. All chairs, crates, and setups must be removed immediately at the end of the Saturday trial. The building will be emptied to be cleaned, equipment and furnishings moved out or rearranged, and two rings will be set up for the obedience trial on Sunday.
- **OBEEDIENCE - NO INDOOR CRATING ALLOWED ON SUNDAY.** Spectator seating for viewing is allowed in the building. Space is limited. Chairs only will be allowed inside (bring your own chair). A **CLEAN TOWEL** and/or **CLEAN MAT** must be placed under your chair to protect the flooring.
- **Outdoor crating** is allowed on the patio on the side of the building all days. Handlers may also work out of their car. Regardless of where handlers crate their dog, it is each handler's responsibility to know when it is their turn in the ring, and to be ready to go in the ring when it is their turn.
- **EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN** will be in the building with the ring steward at the ring. There will not be a door monitor. Exhibitors and spectators will have access to the building during the trial.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
